

# FEMA Help for Tornado Survivors DR-4701-TN April 2023

Individuals & Households in Cannon, Hardeman, Hardin, Haywood, Lewis, Macon, McNairy, Rutherford, Tipton and Wayne

If you had damage or losses from the March 31 - April 1, 2023, storms, you may be eligible for FEMA assistance.

### **Types of Assistance:**

#### **Lodging Expense Reimbursement**

Lodging expenses may be eligible for reimbursement if you verify occupancy in a primary residence within a designated county and

verify that the primary residence is uninhabitable or inaccessible due to the disaster.



## **Rental Assistance for Temporary Housing**

FEMA may be able to provide rent, including a security deposit, if your primary residence was made uninhabitable by the disaster. The assistance includes essential utilities such as electricity and water.

## **Major Repairs and Out-of-Pocket Expenses**

FEMA's Individuals and Household Program is intended to meet the basic needs of your household, not to restore your home and all your personal property items to a pre-disaster condition.

- Housing Assistance covers rent and repairs to structural parts of your home.
- Other Needs Assistance covers disaster-related expenses, such as medical and dental, funeral, furniture, appliances, tools used in your occupation, educational materials, moving and storage, vehicles and generators.

#### **Home Replacement Assistance**

This assistance can help replace an owner-occupied primary residence when the residence is destroyed.
