- 1. Sixteen (16) SCBA Units. All SBCA units shall have a quick disconnect feature and battery included.
 - a. All SCBA units must come with two (2) 4500 psi/45-minute bottles.
 - b. All SCBA units must come with a face mask.
- 2. Extra face masks (beyond the 25 required for the SCBA)
 - a. Seven (7) additional small face masks
 - b. Seven (7) additional medium face masks
- 3. Twenty-five (25) extra SCBA batteries (beyond the 25 required for the SCBAs).

Specifications:

- 1. One (1) unit Specification for a high-pressure compressor and purification system to supply breathing air that meets or exceeds the requirements of CGA Pamphlet G-7, Compressed Air for Human Respiration, the requirements of ANSI/CGA G-7.1, Commodity Specification for Air, Grade E, and all other recognized standards for respirable air. The compressor and the purification system shall be designed and produced by the same Manufacturer. The Manufacturer shall operate under a Quality Management System which complies with the requirements of ISO 9001:2008 for the design, manufacture, inspection, test, and service of air & gas compressors and associated spare parts for commercial and military applications.
- 2. The system shall be designed for a maximum working pressure of 6,000 PSIG. All equipment shall be new and of current design and manufacture.
- 3. All equipment must be delivered, set up, and demonstrated at the address below.
- 4. Unit must be compatible with current SCBA Fill Station Equipment.
- 5. The system shall be supplied on an open vertical steel frame designed for both the static and dynamic loads of the system and of sufficient size to adequately accommodate all of the system's components. The integral base helps eliminate guess work and ensure correct placement / installation allowing for unrestricted cooling air flow to the compressor and prime mover, and providing access for operation and maintenance.
- 6. The system shall be designed for continuous duty operation indoors with room temperatures ranging between 40°F and 115°F¹. Installation shall not require a special foundation; however, it is the responsibility of the purchaser to ensure the installation site has a solid and level foundation that can support the weight of the system as well as the availability of a qualified source of air for the intake of the compressor and adequate ventilation.
- 7. All piping and tubing shall be properly supported and protected to prevent damage from vibration during shipment, operation, or maintenance. Piping and tubing shall be installed in a neat and orderly arrangement, adapting to the contours of the system. All instrument tubing shall be either 300 series stainless steel or pressure rated hose.
- 8. The compressor and purification chambers must be produced by the same manufacture. The compressor shall be an air-cooled, oil lubricated, four stage, three-cylinder, reciprocating compressor.
